A short update from Ron and Debi Williams Missionaries to the Maasai and Warusha, Tanzania, East Africa

We are still in the USA on furlough. We are doing fine and enjoying reporting to some of our supporting churches. We were hoping to be able to book some new churches as we needed to raise more support; but, were not able to book but a few.

The shrinking value of the US dollars is taking its toll as well. Please pray for all your missionaries about this. Each time the interest rate has been lowered in the States, the value of the dollar drops.

We want to thank everyone for your continued prayers and support. I have been going to the doctor while we are here due to the head injury I got in Tanzania. They have been doing tests and trying different medication. At the last appointment, the doctor said that my brain was still swelled up and it was convulsing. This was causing the headache, loss of memory, and confusion.

They have put me on some anti-convulsion medication and so far it seems to be helping a lot. He said that I would need to take the pills indefinitely. He will write me a scrip so I can get enough to take back to Tanzania; but, the generic brand costs \$150 per month. We figure we are going to need about \$4,000 to buy enough to last. Would you please pray about this and if you can help with the cost it would be greatly appreciated?

Our building in Marurani is up and the church held their first meeting there this last Sunday. Praise the Lord! We want to thank all those that gave toward getting the building built. Thank you so much.

We will be going home to Tanzania on June 3, 2008, so not long to go. We are looking forward to getting back and can hardly wait. As always we want to express to you that we believe that we are able to do what God has called us to thanks to your prayers and support. I have said in churches on furlough that we believe that I would have been killed in the attack on us if it were not for your prayers. We know that the souls saved have been prayed into the kingdom of God by saints here in the USA. We thank you and appreciate you with all our heart. Once we get back to Tanzania we would love to have people come over on a mission trip. I know that anyone who comes would be blessed by our people.
