PRAYER REQUEST: One of the young girls in our church in Tanzania needs our prayers. Her name is Rose. She is sixteen years old. Rose has been saved and baptized. I found out at 4am this morning that her parents, who are not Christians, have sold her into marriage to an older man. She did not want to go so they allowed the man and his family to beat her, tie her up, and take her to their boma by force. About eighteen months ago one young girl, who was 12, was killed because she would not stay with the man to whom she was sold. Her uncle allowed the husband's family to beat her until she submitted. They beat her to death. We are very worried about Rose. Please join us in praying for her. Attached *on the next page* is a picture of Rose at her baptism. Thank you.
